General School Reminders

Dinner money on Parent Pay

Please ensure you are regularly checking and topping up your child's Parent Pay accounts where applicable. You can set up low balance alerts if required to notify you when your account falls below a certain value. Parent Pay have also recently activated auto top-up, which will automatically top up by a specified amount when the balance runs low or on a weekly or monthly basis. Please be advised a meal, drink and dessert costs approximately £3.75 per day.



Snacks and Toys

We have noticed an increase in students bringing in snacks and items that are not permitted in school. As a reminder, students should not bring with them fizzy drinks/energy drinks, sweets, lollies or toys (including stress balls). There is currently a particular trend for squishy sensory/stress toys which are filled with liquid, however these burst quite easily and are causing significant disruptions to lessons. Please can you ensure your child is aware that these items should be left at home.



Lost Property

We have a large amount of lost property currently stored in the library, if your child has lost anything whilst at school, please encourage them to check through this with Mr Campbell. We will also be putting all lost property out on the stage area during Tuesday and Wednesday lunch time for students to check. Any items that have not been claimed by the end of the term will be either donated to charity or thrown away.



Bikes

A number of our students opt to cycle at their mode of transport which is a fantastic way to get to and from school. However, a small few of these students are being unsafe particularly at the end of the day, speeding across the front of school and doing wheelies. It is a requirement that students walk with their bike on school grounds to avoid any risk of injury to themselves as well as others. Where applicable, please remind your child to use their bike safely, not just on school grounds but for their full journey.

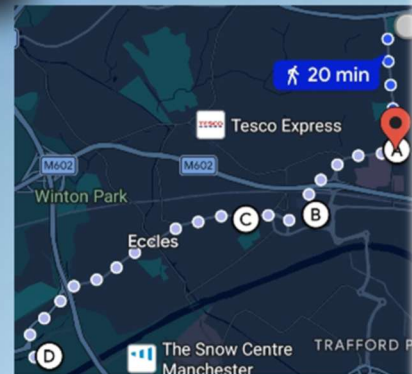
