UKMT Maths Challenge Success

A total of 60 students in year 7 and 8 were put forward for the UKMT Junior Maths challenge. This is a voluntary test and presents students with increasingly challenging maths problems and questions.

Of the students who took the test, a total of 25 have been awarded a certificate, 14 bronze, 8 silver and 3 gold. We would like to congratulate these students for this fantastic success.

We would also like to recognise the dedication of all students who took part, this challenge is an excellent way to advance their education in maths.

Blackpool Trip Competition



For each week between **11th May and 3rd July**, if your child achieves 100% attendance, they will receive an Attendance Ticket. If your child achieves 100% attendance for the whole of this period they will receive a maximum of 7 Attendance Tickets.

On **3rd July**, all Attendance Tickets will go into a draw for a place on a trip to Blackpool Pleasure beach towards the end of the school year. A total of 30 places will be drawn and each student will be able to choose a friend to join them (however their attendance must be a minimum of 90% at the time of the draw). This means a total of 60 students will be able to attend this trip.

The trip dates are:

Year 9 and year 10 – Thursday 9th July

Year 7 and year 8 – Thursday 16th July

It's important to remember that punctuality can affect your child's attendance, arriving late can lose 50% of their mark for that day so make sure your child arrives on time to help them secure tickets in the draw!
