# Blackpool Trip Competition



For each week between **11<sup>th</sup> May and 3<sup>rd</sup> July**, if your child achieves 100% attendance, they will receive an Attendance Ticket. If your child achieves 100% attendance for the whole of this period they will receive a maximum of 7 Attendance Tickets.

On **3<sup>rd</sup> July**, all Attendance Tickets will go into a draw for a place on a trip to Blackpool Pleasure beach towards the end of the school year. A total of 30 places will be drawn and each student will be able to choose a friend to join them (however their attendance must be a minimum of 90% at the time of the draw). This means a total of 60 students will be able to attend this trip.
