Punctuality

We recently sent out communication regarding punctuality to school. This advises that from Monday 15th June, students will receive a same day 20 minute detention if they are late to school. It is important that you notify school of any exceptional reason for lateness so that we can ensure they do not receive a detention in these cases.

Uniform

From next week, the process has changed for how we manage students who do not arrive meeting the school uniform standards. Students who do not meet our uniform expectations may be provided with spare uniform, where available. If spare uniform is unavailable, the student will either be placed in Reflection until the issue is resolved, or parents/carers will be contacted and asked to bring in the correct uniform or collect their child from school.

Whilst it is useful and often important to send this to heads of year, they are not always able to forward this to the reception team before they are requesting to leave. This can often cause un-necessary delays as we cannot release a student without this confirmation for safeguarding reasons.

Blackpool Trip Competition



For each week between **11th May and 3rd July**, if your child achieves 100% attendance, they will receive an Attendance Ticket. If your child achieves 100% attendance for the whole of this period they will receive a maximum of 7 Attendance Tickets.

On **3rd July**, all Attendance Tickets will go into a draw for a place on a trip to Blackpool Pleasure beach towards the end of the school year. A total of 30 places will be drawn and each student will be able to choose a friend to join them (however their attendance must be a minimum of 90% at the time of the draw). 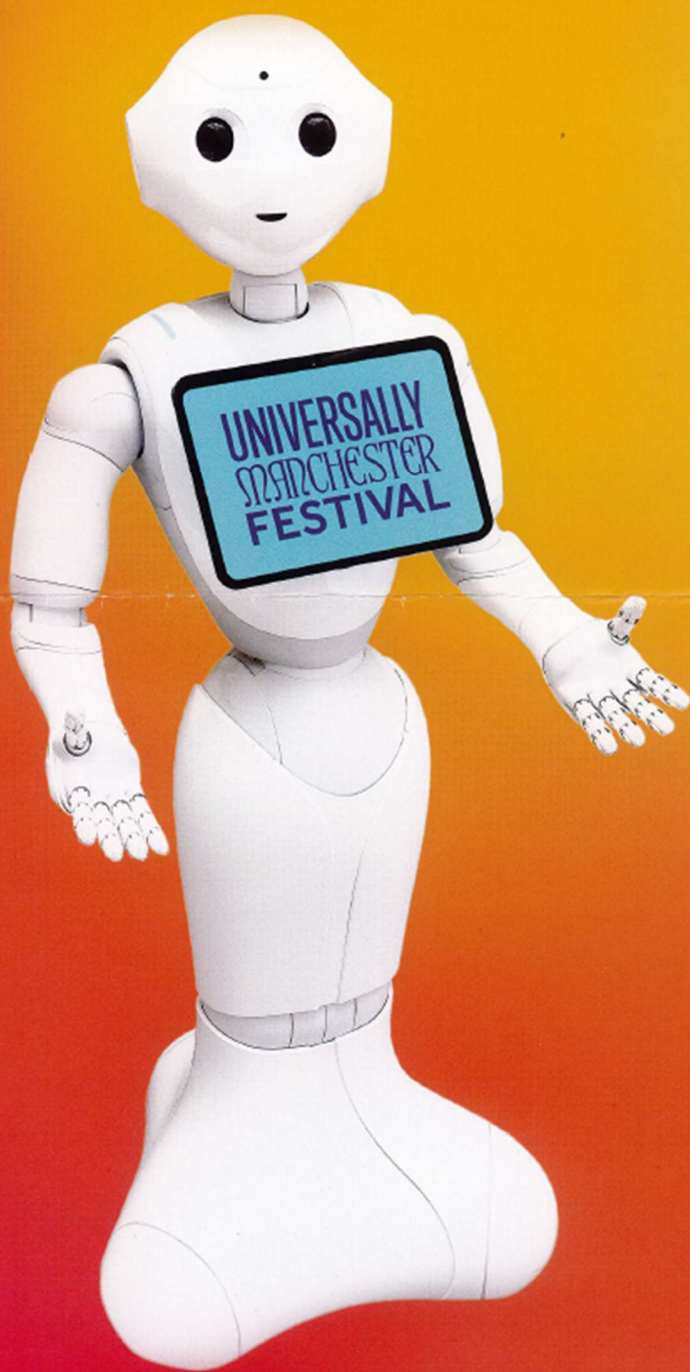
