# Re Onsite testing of students in September

You may already be aware that from 16 August 2021, children under the age of 18 years old will no longer be required to self-isolate if they are identified as a close contact of a positive COVID-19 case. Instead, children will be contacted by NHS Test and Trace, informed they have been in close contact with a positive case and advised to take a PCR test.

Although the latest guidance issued is very positive as it means that we are no longer required to send home 'bubbles' or 'close contacts' testing still remains important in reducing the risk of transmission of infection within schools.

Over the summer, staff and secondary pupils should continue to test regularly if they are attending settings that remain open, such as summer schools and out of school activities based in school settings. Regular testing will then pause in schools over the summer if they are closed. However, testing will still be widely available over the summer and kits can be collected either from your local pharmacy or ordered online.

## Testing of students upon return to school in September

As students will potentially mix with lots of other people during the summer holidays, the government have advised that all secondary school students should receive <u>2 on-site lateral flow device tests</u>, <u>3 to 5 days apart</u>, <u>upon their return to school in the autumn term</u>.</u>

## <u>Consent</u>

As many parents/carers have already given consent for their child to be tested this year we are not requesting this again, however, if you did not give consent during the testing that took place in March & June and wish to do so now please complete the consent form below.
