Activities overview:

Maths- Ratios/sequences/ re-cap of basic numeracy activities for consolidation.

English- Creative writing, script writing- focus on Roald Dahl.

Science- Wildlife, food chains & urban environments. Pollination & pollinators. Plant seeds & growth. Practical activities- making plant seed 'bombs' & bird feeders.

ICT- E-safety, digital citizenship, computer systems (input, process, output & software), assessment on Frog Play

Art- Spray painting abstract backgrounds, stencilling, ink paintings, etching using Sgraffito method- oil pastel etching piece of flowers and landscapes.

Photography- Use of lighting in photography, glow sticks, fairy lights, torches.

PE- Numerous activities including rounders, dodgeball, table tennis, nerf howler, tug 'o' war.

Spanish- Introduction to Spanish greetings through games, flash cards & challenges.

Celebration & Awards Assembly:

At the end of the week parents/carers were invited in for an awards assembly. The Year 10 young leaders selected 5 students from each group who they felt represented our mission statement and values; Vibrant, Inclusive, Proud and two special awards for Kindness and Excellence. The winners were presented with a book called 'The Boy at the Back of the Classroom', which offers a child's perspective on the importance of friendship and kindness.

Staffing

Each day there were two lead senior members of staff, 5 teaching staff, 7 support staff (to support pupils with SEND & medical needs).

The lead staff were responsible for health & safety, safeguarding, COVID 19 and overall decision making.

Year 10 young leaders- 30 Year 10 students also volunteered their time to help at summer school. They were assigned to a group for the week and selected the recipients of the awards.
