### **TALK LIKE A GRAPHIC DESIGNER**

MINIMALISM - Minimalist art focuses on things like geometry, line, and color. It tends to be simple and have less content or detail

**SYMBOLISM** – Is the artistic use of an item or object to represent something. E.g. a heart to represent love

<u>GRAPHIC DESIGN</u> - Combines images and words to convey information to an audience, it is often more simplistic and quicker to grasp the meaning of - such as in posters, advertising and product packaging

<u>MESSAGE</u> -The purpose of works of art may be to communicate personal ideas, beliefs, meaning and information to the observer

#### TALK AND ACT LIKE AN ENVIRONMENTALIST TO HELP THE EARTH

<u>SUSTAINABILITY</u> – Using materials in a way that will not damage the environment. This avoids depletion of natural resources and lessens excessive waste production

<u>RECYCLING</u> — The conversion of waste materials into materials for another use — e.g. the metal in a car being re used to make fridges or another car

<u>GREEN ENERGY</u> — Using wind, sun or wave energy to produce electricity for use. Rather than using fossil fuels or natural gas which can destroy, deplete and pollute the Earth

<u>ENVIROMENTALIST</u>—Someone who considers how their actions impact on the environment e.g., recycling waste, not littering, walking instead of using a car, being considerate to the habitat they live in
