Parent/Carer:

We will:

- Ensure that my/our child attends school **every day** and **on time**.

- Ensure I have provided two phone numbers that can be used for emergency contact
- Engage with the school on all necessary matters in a positive and respectful manner.

Student:

I will:

- Attend school every day and arrive on time for form time and for all lessons.
- Behave according to the school's minimum student expectations at all times.
- Bring all the equipment I need every day: pen, pencil, rubber, ruler and calculator as a minimum in a pencil case, all the books that I am given, PE kit in a school bag. Also, ensure I have my maximise folder and reading book in school each day.

- Do all my classwork and homework as well as I can and on time.

- Never have a mobile phone turned on in the school building, and if I do have a mobile phone, I will make sure it is safely put away at all times during the school day.
