




# CHRISTMAS MOCK EXAM PREPARATION AND LINKS

## English

The mocks will contain a full set of papers assessing every aspect of the curriculum.

- **Literature**, this means revising: Romeo and Juliet, A Christmas Carol, An Inspector Calls, and the poetry anthology.
- **For Language**, this means revising the 'Point/Comment' method for section A, and writing skills for section B.
- Use the revision materials you have been given to help you prepare for the exams. These are so on Command Centre.

## Maths

The mock exams will contain a **full set** of maths papers assessing the whole maths curriculum.

To revise:

- **Method maths:**
  - Centre ID is ellesmere
  - Username is your name, no spaces, capitalise the first letter of both first and surname
  - Password is your date of birth
- **Maths Genie** – watch the video, complete the questions, check your solutions
- **Sparx Independent Learning** – great for application questions

## Science

Remember, you will be sitting 2 biology, 2 chemistry and 2 physics papers.

**Biology Paper 1** - B1 to B4.

**Chemistry Paper 1** – C1 to C5.

**Physics Paper 1** – P1 to P4.

**Biology Paper 2** – B5 and lots of Paper 1 required practical questions.

**Chemistry Paper 2** - C6 and lots of Paper 1 required practical questions.

**Physics Paper 2** – P5 and lots of Paper 1 required practical questions.

# Interleaving

For example, instead of organising your revision like this:

A much more effective way of organising your revision would look like this:

M	T	W	T	F
MACBETH	UNSEEN POETRY	AN INSPECTOR CALLS	JEKYLL AND HYDE	CREATIVE WRITING
AN INSPECTOR CALLS	JEKYLL AND HYDE	CREATIVE WRITING	MACBETH	UNSEEN POETRY

With interleaving, students learn by tackling a mix of related concepts, forcing the brain to work hard to recall prior learning and determine which strategies or skills to use to solve them.
